

DRAUGHT BEERS

PILSNER URQUELL

Origin: Czech Republic

Strength: 4,4% ABV

This very light beer which tastes firmly of hops has a strength of just 4.4%. It was the inspiration for the type of beer known as Pils, a very pale lager with a decidedly bitter and refreshing taste which is probably the oldest in the world.

GROLSCH HEFEWEIZEN

Origin: Holland

Strength: 5,1% ABV

Grolsch Premium Weizen is a Dutch beer inspired by the traditional German wheat beers. Grolsch Hefeweizen is a “pure” version of Weizenbier, cloudy, top-fermented and unfiltered, with a creamy head and sweet fruity aroma giving off hints of banana and ripe pineapple. Very thirst-quenching.

GUINNESS

Origin: Ireland

Strength: 4,2% ABV

Guinness is the classic Irish stout porter produced in Dublin's famous St. James's Gate Brewery by the company founded in 1759 by Arthur Guinness. The beer looks dark, almost black, but its color is in fact officially a dark shade of ruby. The head is white and very creamy. Made with water, malted barley, unmalted roasted barley, hops and yeast, Guinness takes its color and its characteristic taste from its special barley roasting process. It is then pasteurized and filtered in a production and fermentation cycle which lasts about 10 days.

ANYTIME IPA

Origin: England

Strength: 4,7% ABV

Anytime IPA is a beer defined by a strong and bitter hop with a long lasting taste. Its malt flavour blends with the hop aftertaste all together in a lovely amber color. This IPA is neat and well balanced, very easy and pleasurable to drink.

ST. BENOÎT BLANCHE

Origin: Belgium

Strength: 5,0% ABV

The Brasserie Du Bocq brewery was founded in 1858 at Purnode in Belgium by the Belot family and is still today one of the last family-run craft breweries for top-fermented beer. The St. Benoit Blanche is a high quality top-fermented Belgian Witbier with a cloudy appearance. From the very first sip you can taste its smoothness and delicacy that make it an exceptional drink; typical of Belgian ales it is fragrant and intensely fruity.

ST. BENOÎT TRIPEL

Origin: Belgium

Strength: 8% ABV

The Saint Benoit Tripel, with a slightly cloudy light blonde colour and thick creamy foam, is inspired by the Belgian abbey brewing tradition. Despite the high percentage it maintains its light bodied spirit as well as the fresh and dry fruited aroma.

ST. BENOÎT AMBRÉE

Origin: Belgium

Strength: 5,9% ABV

The fruity notes which emerge from top-fermentation blend harmoniously with the more dominant notes of licorice and caramel. The bitter aftertaste is the outcome of a complex alchemy between selected malts and fine hops releasing a typical hint of chocolate.
